I've been a celebrant since the beginning of 2018, and I can only describe my desire to become one as a 'calling' I adore meeting people, and I relish hearing the stories my couples share with me: that first, best or unexpected kiss, the first date, meetings each other's friends and families, the proposal...all those amazing, extraordinary moments that make up a love story. And I love being the one responsible for starting your legally-binding 'happily-ever-after'.

My first ceremony was in December 2018. Standing on Wonona Beach early that morning, with the water washing over our feet, we legalised the vows the couple had made in their lavish, but not legally recognised, wedding in Bali six months prior. It was a simple elopement ceremony, and it was very lovely. Their attendants watched on, and the whole group went out for breakfast afterwards. I've done quite a few ceremonies between then and now, from elopements to 180-guest weddings, and I can honestly say that every type of ceremony has its own special beauty.

My background is high school English teaching which gives me a bit of an edge: I know how to guide you to put together a great ceremony, I write and speak well, I know how to engage an audience from small, cosy groups to large crowds, and I am, and always have been, a 'people person'. (I'm even being the celebrant for some of my ex-students soon which is probably one of the greatest 'teacher' compliments I could be paid!)

People describe me as a warm, generous, considerate, intelligent, well organised, creative and calm. I'm a genuinely nice person (I like who I am). I am also enthusiastic; when I do something, I give it 110%, and I am absolutely passionate about being a marriage celebrant! A legal-only ceremony if you just want to get married and get on with the honeymoon. It will just be the two of you, your two witnesses and your photographer. My service includes:

- Completion of your Notice of Intended Marriage which must be signed a minimum of one month before your ceremony
- Conducting a legal ceremony at a location of your choosing
- Completion of all legal documentation and registration of your marriage with the Department of Births, Deaths and Marriages
- Presentation marriage certificate on the day
- you have the option of adding your own personal vows
- I can order your Standard Marriage Certificate for you. This will incur the fee charged by Births, Deaths and Marriages.
- I have Public Liability and Professional Indemnity insurance to cover my services.

My service includes:

Your ceremony can take place in a beautiful outdoor location of your choice without you being concerned about proximity to electrical outlets. Bluetooth capability means that one of your trusted guests can connect their mobile phone to my PA and play the processional, signing and recessional music of your choice. Note: I ask that you provide me with the details of your chosen music, so I have a copy 'just in case'. (I'm a Plan B person!)
- Having two PA systems means one system can break down and we will still have sound AND my PA systems will cater for large outdoor ceremonies with no problems at all. The system includes wireless microphones, so your family and friends will hear all the lovely detail of your story as well as the promises you make to one another.

- Unlimited contact with me via phone, email or face-to-face. I will get back to you – even if it's just to let you know I've received your message – within 24 hours.
- An information booklet and ceremony guide. This booklet package includes all sorts of useful (and essential) information about getting married in Australia as well as how to build a ceremony. (I do this for you, but under your guidance, and the booklet helps you decide what to include, things you might like to add, things you might like to change.)
- A comprehensive collection of personal vows inspiration and readings if required. It can be overwhelming trying to put the depth of your feelings into words. If you're struggling to articulate how you feel, I can show you how other people have written their own vows. (I even have a fun creative writing activity or two that might help!)
- Ideas for readings if required. With my love of literature and my extensive library of readings, I can streamline your search to find the perfect piece for your ceremony.
- Ideas and as much contact as you need to assist you with any questions involving your ceremony. I want your ceremony to be perfect and I will work hard to make sure it's exactly what you envisage. I love being asked questions; it means you're invested in your ceremony, and it means that you'll appreciate my hard work.
- A ceremony that reflects your relationship and your goals for your wedding. Unless we have arranged otherwise, I will send your draft ceremony to you about a month before your wedding. This means that together we will create a ceremony that is uniquely you. Your ceremony sets the tone for the reception that it to follow, so it's imperative that we get this right.

- A rehearsal if you'd like one. You will feel much less nervous on the big day. Everyone will know their entrances, their exits, where to stand, how to exchange rings, how to use the microphone. You've got this!
