EXTRA INFORMATION

REPERTOIRE

It should be noted that some venues or celebrants, due to religious and secular reasons, may have particular requirements on the type of music you have during your ceremony

OUTDOOR CEREMONIES

Due to the fragile nature of the harp and electrical equipment there must be adequate cover from the elements in place

ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS

For the Ceremony it isn't necessary to have power points, though it is preferred. However, for the Reception a power point is required

CONTACT

When you're ready please get in touch with the following details and be sure to contact us regarding any queries or requests

- VENUE Other than the address, it is useful to know whether it is indoors or outdoors, if it is a full Mass Service, if it is in a difficult to reach location, or if there is limited parking
- **REPERTOIRE**If you are looking for Ceremonial Music please look over the repertoire
lists and decide which pieces you would like for each section of the
ceremony (don't forget repertoire requests must be discussed up to
3 months before the wedding)
Should you decide to have Reception Music, you may choose the song
for your First Dance
- ATTIRE Keeping in harmony with your wedding's colour scheme is crucial for the overall aesthetic of the ceremony
